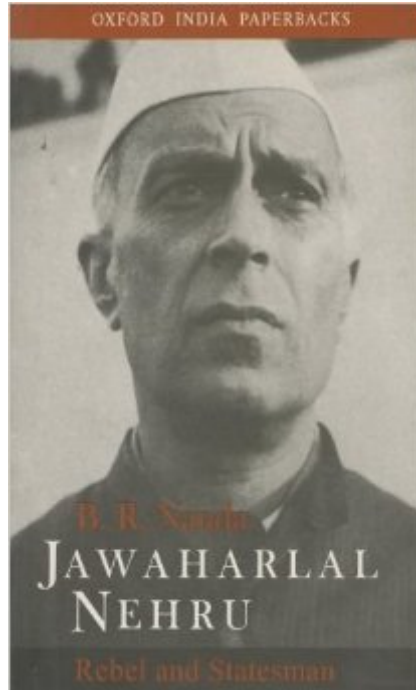


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Jawaharlal Nehru: Rebel And Statesman (Oxford India Paperbacks)
